

Job Description Friendship Church

Position: Senior High Worship Leader (2) (a Non-Exempt position)

Reports to: Director of Senior High Ministry and Pastor of Student Ministries

Hours: Six hours per week with 32 hour maximum per month, afternoons and evenings

Hired by: Director of Senior High Ministry and Pastor of Student Ministries with Leadership Team approval

Summary Description:

The two Senior High Worship Leaders work in cooperation with, and under the direction of, the Director of Senior High Ministries and the Pastor of Student Ministries to lead high school students in worship of God and to further the evangelistic efforts of Friendship Church. The Senior High Worship Leaders share the responsibility to lead worship through a rotation schedule. Prior to the worship services they interact with the students, forming meaningful relationships that help form a bridge between the music they offer and the reality of Christ in the daily lives of the students. They offer students fellowship, encouragement, and prayer in appropriate ways in service to our Lord Jesus Christ.

Overview of Job:

- Select the music that will be performed by the Senior High Worship Team during worship services
- Recruit and develop the Senior High Worship Team into an enthusiastic contemporary Christian musical group that honors and glorifies the Lord Jesus Christ
- Embolden the Senior High Worship Team to accountable personal spiritual maturity in Christ
- Collaborate with the Director of Senior High Ministry in creating a worship environment appropriate to the weekly talk and to the appropriate character of The River ministry
- Direct rehearsals and performances of the Senior High Worship Team
- Collaborate with the sound, light, and audio visual coordinators for effective worship presentation
- Supervise use of Friendship Church audio equipment
- Prepare the PowerPoint slide program for the worship service (or delegate this to students)

Additional Responsibilities:

- Participate in the Fall Retreat in October during MEA week school break
- Participate in the Winter Retreat in January during school break
- Attend various meetings, conferences, seminars, classes, etc., as required
- Various other responsibilities as required
