### **Summary Description:**

The two Campus Directors of The Zone Ministry of Friendship Church partner to provide 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade ministry programs and environments that are relevant and palatable to the student culture and encourages students to experience the presence and power of a relationship with God. The Directors lead separately at each of Friendship Church's two campuses.

### **Additional Responsibilities:**

- Set, monitor, and attain long-range goals along with practical programs that impact life decisions/choices of 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade Students
- Minister to parents/families of 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade Students
- Teach the full Word of God in 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade Student programs (Sundays, Wednesdays, etc.)
- Supervise and train volunteer 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade Student Ministry staff
- Develop appropriate goal-driven activities and events for 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade Students
- Develop, administer, and assume accountability with the Director of Junior High Student Ministries for financial budget of 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade Student Ministries
- Attend various conferences, seminars, classes, etc., as required
- Various other responsibilities as required
